Psalm 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call His name **Immanuel**.

Isaiah 8:7-8

- (7) Now therefore, behold, the Lord brings up upon them the waters of the river, strong and many, *even* the king of Assyria, and all his glory: and he shall come up over all his channels, and go over all his banks:
- (8) And he shall pass through Judah; he shall overflow and go over, he shall reach *even* to the neck; and the stretching out of his wings shall fill the breadth of your land, O **Immanuel**.
- Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a **child is born, unto us a son is given**: and the government shall be upon His shoulders: and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, **The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.**
- Jeremiah 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this *is* His name by which He shall be called, THE **LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS**.
- Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and **they shall look upon Me Whom they have pierced**, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.
- Matthew 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call His name **Emmanuel**, which means, **God with us**.
- Matthew 7:21 Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of **My Father** Who is in heaven.

Mark 14:61-62

- (61) But He held His peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, and said unto Him, **are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed**?
- (62) And Jesus said, **I am**: and you shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Luke 5:17-26

(17) And it came to pass on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, who had come from every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was *present* to heal them.

- (18) And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought *means* to bring him in, and to lay *him* before Him.
- (19) And when they could not find by what *way* they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with *his* couch into the midst before Jesus.
- (20) And when He saw their faith, He said unto him, Man, your sins are forgiven you.
- (21) And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this Who speaks blasphemies? **Who can forgive sins, but God alone**?
- (22) But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answering said unto them, What are you reasoning in your hearts?
- (23) Which is easier, to say, Your sins be forgiven you; or to say, Rise up and walk?
- (24) But that you may know that the Son of man has power upon earth to forgive sins, (He said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto you, Arise, and take up your couch, and go into your house.
- (25) And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.
- (26) And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.
- Luke 7:16 And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That **God has visited His people**.
- John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the **Word** was God.

John 5:17-30

- (17) But Jesus answered them, My Father works until now, and I work.
- (18) Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill Him, because **He** not only had broken the sabbath, but **said also that God was His Father**, **making Himself equal with God**.
- (19) Then Jesus answered and said unto them, Truly, truly, I say unto you, The **Son** can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the **Father** do: for whatever things He does, the Son does also.
- (20) For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does: and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel.
- (21) For as the Father raises up the dead, and quickens *them*; even so the Son quickens whom He will.
- (22) For the Father judges no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son:
- (23) That all *men* should honor the Son, even as they honor the Father. He that does not honor the Son does not honor the Father Who has sent Him.
- (24) Truly, I say unto you, He that hears My word, and believes on Him Who sent Me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but has passed from death unto life.
- (25) Truly, truly, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the **Son of God**: and they that hear shall live.
- (26) For as the Father has life in Himself; so has He given to the Son to have life in Himself;
- (27) And has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of man.

- (28) Do not marvel at this: for the hour is coming, in which all who are in the graves shall hear His voice,
- (29) And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.
- (30) I can of Mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and My judgment is just; because I seek not Mine own will, but the will of the Father Who has sent Me.
- John 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that you shall die in your sins: for if you do not believe that **I am** *He*, you shall die in your sins.

John 8:54-58

- (54) Jesus answered, If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing: it is My Father that honors me; of whom you say, that He is your God:
- (55) Yet you have not known Him; but I know Him: and if I should say, I do not know Him, I shall be a liar like you: but I know Him, and keep His saying.
- (56) Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day: and he saw it, and was glad.
- (57) Then said the Jews to Him, You are not yet fifty years old, and You have seen Abraham?
- (58) Jesus said to them, Truly, truly, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

John 10:30-36

- (30) I and My Father are one.
- (31) Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him.
- (32) Jesus answered them, I have shown you many good works from My Father; for which of those works do you stone Me?
- (33) The Jews answered Him, saying, For a good work we do not stone You; but for **blasphemy**; and because You, **being a man, make Yourself God**.
- (34) Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, you are gods?
- (35) If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken:
- (36) Do you say you to Him, Whom the Father has sanctified, and sent into the world, you blaspheme; because **I said**, **I am the Son of God**?
- John 13:3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that **He had come from God**, and was returning to God;

John 14:9-11

- (9) Jesus said to him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet have you not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; and how do you say *then*, Show us the Father?
- (10) Do you not believe that **I am in the Father**, **and the Father in Me**? The words that I speak to you I do not speak of Myself: but the Father who dwells in Me, He does the works.
- (11) Believe Me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else believe Me for the very works' sake.
- John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify Me with Your own self with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 20:28 And Thomas answered and said to him, My Lord and My God.

Acts 7:59 And they stoned Stephen, **calling upon** *God***, and saying, Lord Jesus**, receive my spirit.

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to **feed the church of God**, **which He has purchased with His own blood**.

- (6) For God, Who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, has shined in our hearts, to *give* the light of the knowledge of the **glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.**

Philippians 2:5-6

- (5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in **Christ Jesus**:
- (6) Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

Colossians 1:14-17

- (14) In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins:
- (15) Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:
- (16) For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they are* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him:
- (17) And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist.

Colossians 2:9 For in Him dwells all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: **God was manifest in the flesh**, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

1 Timothy 6:13-16

- (13) I give you charge in the sight of God, Who quickens all things, and *before* Christ Jesus, Who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;
- (14) That you keep *this* commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our **Lord Jesus Christ**:
- (15) Who in His times He shall show, W**ho is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords**;
- (16) **Who only has immortality**, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; Whom no man has seen, nor can see: to Whom are honor and power everlasting. Amen.

Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of **the great God** and our Savior Jesus Christ;

Hebrews 1:2-8

- (2) has in these last days spoken unto us by *His* Son, Whom He has appointed heir of all things, by Whom also He made the worlds;
- (3) Who being **the brightness of** *His* **glory**, **and the express image of** *His* **person**, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;
- (4) Being made so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.
- (5) For unto which of the angels did He say at any time, **You are my Son**, this day have I begotten You? And again, **I will be a Father to Him, and He shall be a Son to Me**?
- (6) And again, when He brings in the firstbegotten into the world, He says, And let all the angels of God worship Him.
- (7) And of the angels He said, Who makes his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire.
- (8) But **unto the Son** *He said*, **Your throne**, **O** *God*, *is* for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness *is* the sceptre of Your kingdom.
- 1 John 3:16 Hereby we perceive the love *of God*, because He laid down His life for us: and we ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren.
- 1 John 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, **the Word**, and the Holy Spirit: and these three are one.
- Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, said **the Lord**, **Who is, and Who was, and Who is to come, the Almighty**.

Revelation 19:11-16

- (11) And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He Who sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.
- (12) His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on His head *were* many crowns; and He had a name written, that no man knew, but He Himself.
- (13) And He *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and **His name is called The Word of God.**
- (14) And the armies *which were* in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.
- (15) And out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
- (16) And He has on *His* vesture and on His thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS**, **AND LORD OF LORDS**.
